



The scaba Spring Contest will take place on Sunday 24th February 2019 at The Hawth theatre in Crawley. The contest format is closed adjudication and all bands will perform an 'own choice' Test Piece and March. Bands may play any suitable test piece.

All bands will be graded as, and compete in, the same section for this contest as they are graded for the National Championships of their home country.

Bands that do not compete in the National Championships and are not in the Regional grading tables will compete in the **Ungraded Section**.

Players competing in the Ungraded section do not need to be registered. Please refer to the scaba Contesting & Registration rules for more details.

Our adjudicator for this contest is Tom Hutchinson. Tom Hutchinson is the principal cornet player of the world famous Cory Band, a Professor of Cornet at the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama, Brass specialist with Ev-entz Music, Cornet tutor for the National Youth Brass Band of Wales and Cornet tutor for the National Children's Brass Band of Great Britain. Tom's work as adjudicator includes the Senior Trophy of the British Open Championships' Spring Festival.
