

# Southern Counties Youth Band (SCYB)

## Membership:

Membership of SCYB is open to all players of standard brass band instruments\* and percussionists aged from 11 to 18 years old\*\*. Your 'parent' band does not have to be a member of scaba.

The annual subscription (per academic year) is £60, discounted to £50 for players from scaba Member bands<sup>o</sup>.

New members are welcome to join the band at any time during the year; players are welcome to come along to their first rehearsal for free before deciding if membership is right for them!

Whilst we encourage all members to attend as many SCYB rehearsals and events as possible, we do understand that commitments to schoolwork, exams and your 'parent' bands must take priority.

Seating positions within the band will be determined by the conductor and tutors. They will take into account your strengths as players and the needs of the band, and may change during the year. It may be necessary to ask stronger players to play less demanding parts to balance the band and to give support and encouragement to other players.

Contravention of these basic rules or any acts which, in the opinion of the tutors are detrimental to the proper running or reputation of the band, may result in the suspension of membership or expulsion from the band.

Members are responsible at all times for the safety and insurance of their instruments and possessions. If you do not own the instrument you are playing, please check with the owner that it is adequately insured for use with SCYB.

scaba, SCYB and the tutors cannot accept responsibility for any loss of, or damage to, any member's possessions whilst attending any rehearsal, concert or function of the band. scaba cannot accept liability for any accidents, however caused, involving members of the band. Responsibility for Health and Safety and Security will be that of the venue SCYB is using for each rehearsal/event.
